This Styrian band, first formed in 2002 have continued to utilize their native tongue as a colourful lyrical medium to convey meaning and attitude across a range of genres. Their songs cover a vast spectrum of styles from funk to reggae, folk to blues, classic rock to jazz and are laced with psychedelic and progressive facets to create a truly contemporary sensation. In 2007, Push'n'funk released their first self titled album which included twelve tracks.
